CISV Jacksonville was founded in 1976; one of 22 CISV chapters in the US (only chapter in Florida); the US is among 70 participating countries. CISV Jacksonville's main programs are:

- **Village:** Four-week international camp for 11-year-olds.
- **Interchange:** Family-centered exchange between two international chapters for 12-13 year-olds.
- **Step-Up:** Three-week international camp for 14-15 year-olds.
- **Youth Meeting:** Short camps featuring themes for 12-13 year-olds to explore intercultural issues.
- **Junior Branch:** CISVers between the ages of 11 - 25 who develop their intercultural and leadership skills through organizing and taking part in educational and social activities--local children do not have to travel to participate in monthly Junior Branch activities.

Additional programs are available for older students and many provide leadership opportunities for staff and junior counselors. In addition to local programs, in the summer of 2014, CISV Jacksonville will send more than 30 representatives to 7 locations around the world, including:

- Villages in Dallas, Denmark, Detroit and Norway
- Italy as part of Interchange
- Switzerland for Youth Meeting
- Summer Camps in Brandywine Valley, PA, Sweden and Costa Rica
